



## Park County organizations working to address issues identified in the 2023 We Will Park County Report

Ninety-six percent (96%) of our community survey respondents want to see our challenges resolved locally, but more than half (51%) said they weren't aware of any local entities working to address our county's challenges. Therefore, we are taking this opportunity to introduce a range of organizations and governmental agencies currently working on key issues.
